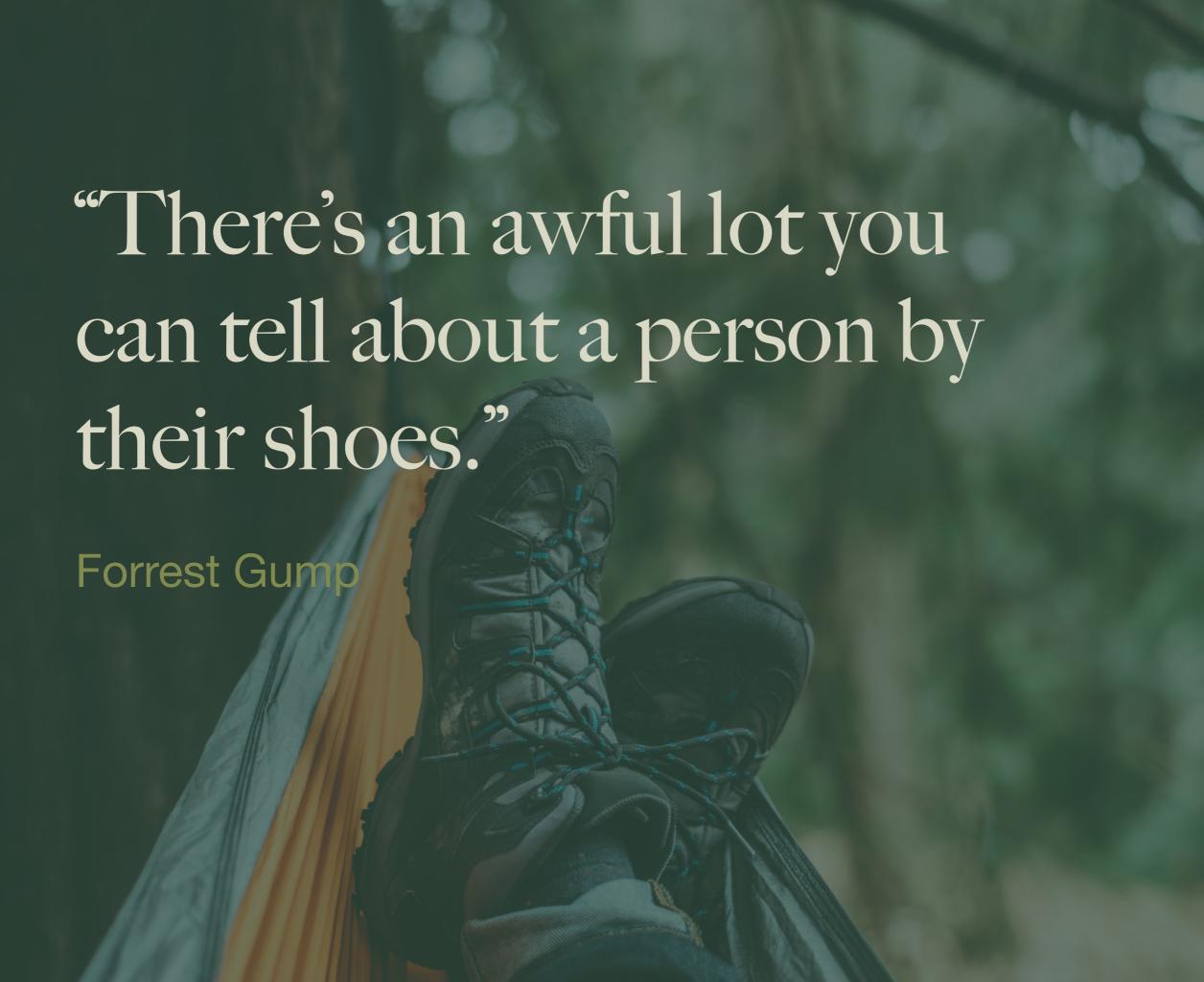
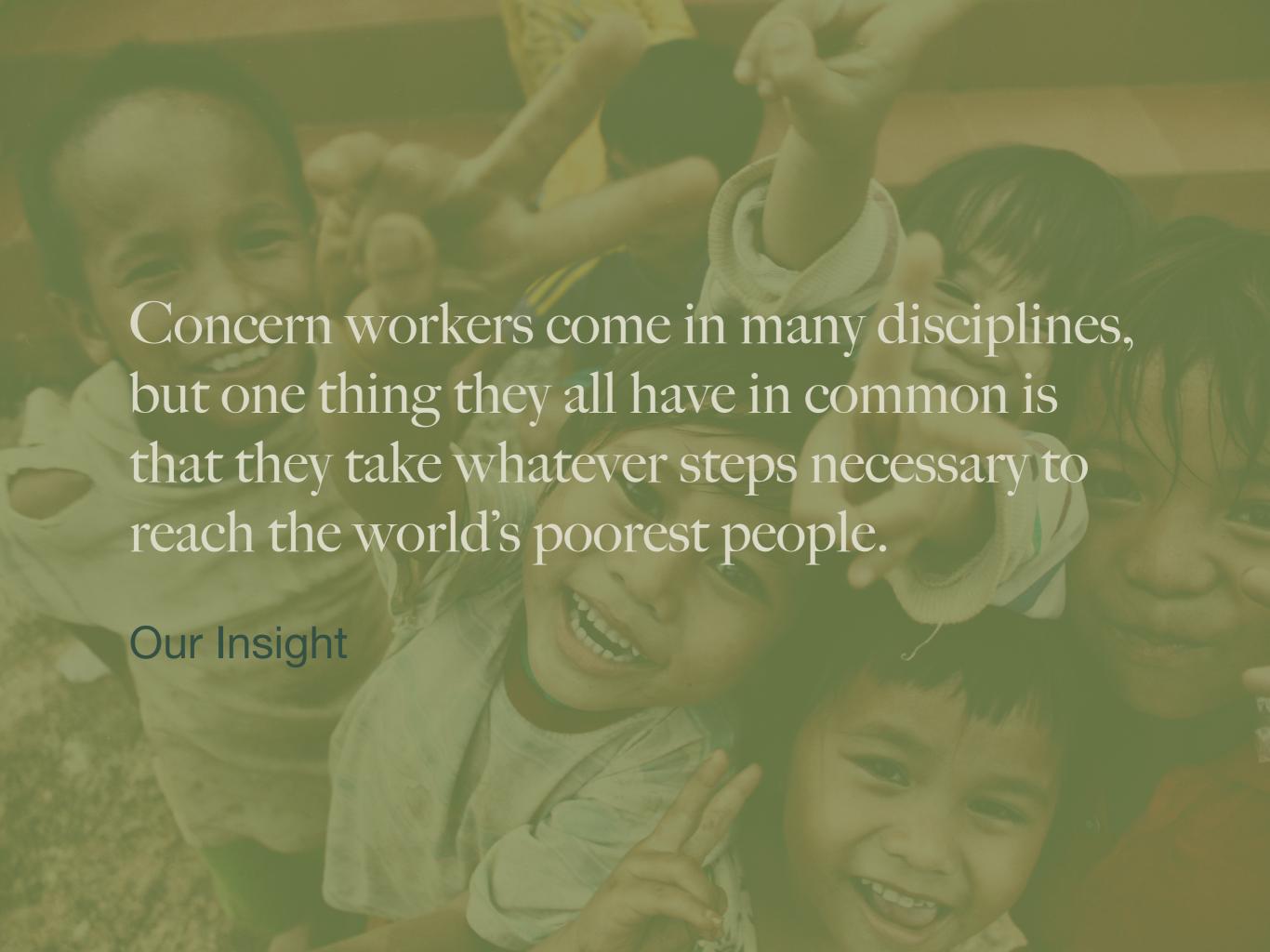

Our Idea





We want to create a film that will resonate with millennials in a unique way - by leveraging a cultural phenomenon which they can relate to.

We believe there is a fascinating contrast in the passion that young people show for box-fresh sneakers, which they carefully maintain, and the well-worn, well-used boots and shoes worn by Concern's staff. Every sneaker, boot and shoe has a story to tell - whether it's a coveted Nike or Adidas release, or the boots worn by a Concern field worker bringing clean water to villages across South Sudan.

Our target audience has a huge interest in fashion, including streetwear and sneaker culture. Beyond this, just about everyone can relate to putting on a pair of shoes and going to work.

The idea behind our execution is simple. We want to demonstrate the lengths that Concern goes to to help those in need - by telling the individual stories of your staff. We will do this by creating a vlog for the big screen - in which a sneakerhead will review the well-worn shoes of Concern staff, and talk to the audience about just how far those shoes have taken their owner - and how this can help change lives.

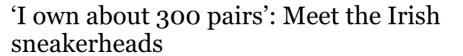

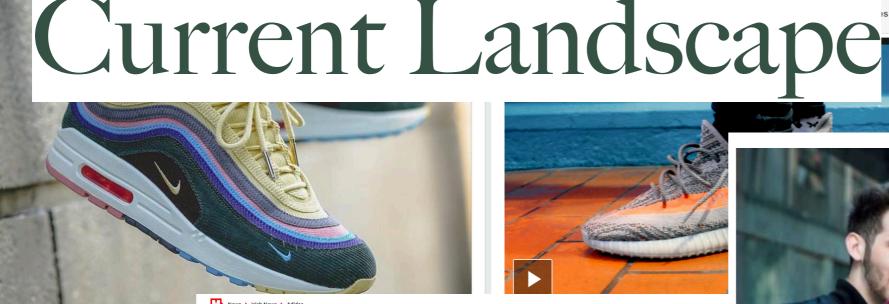

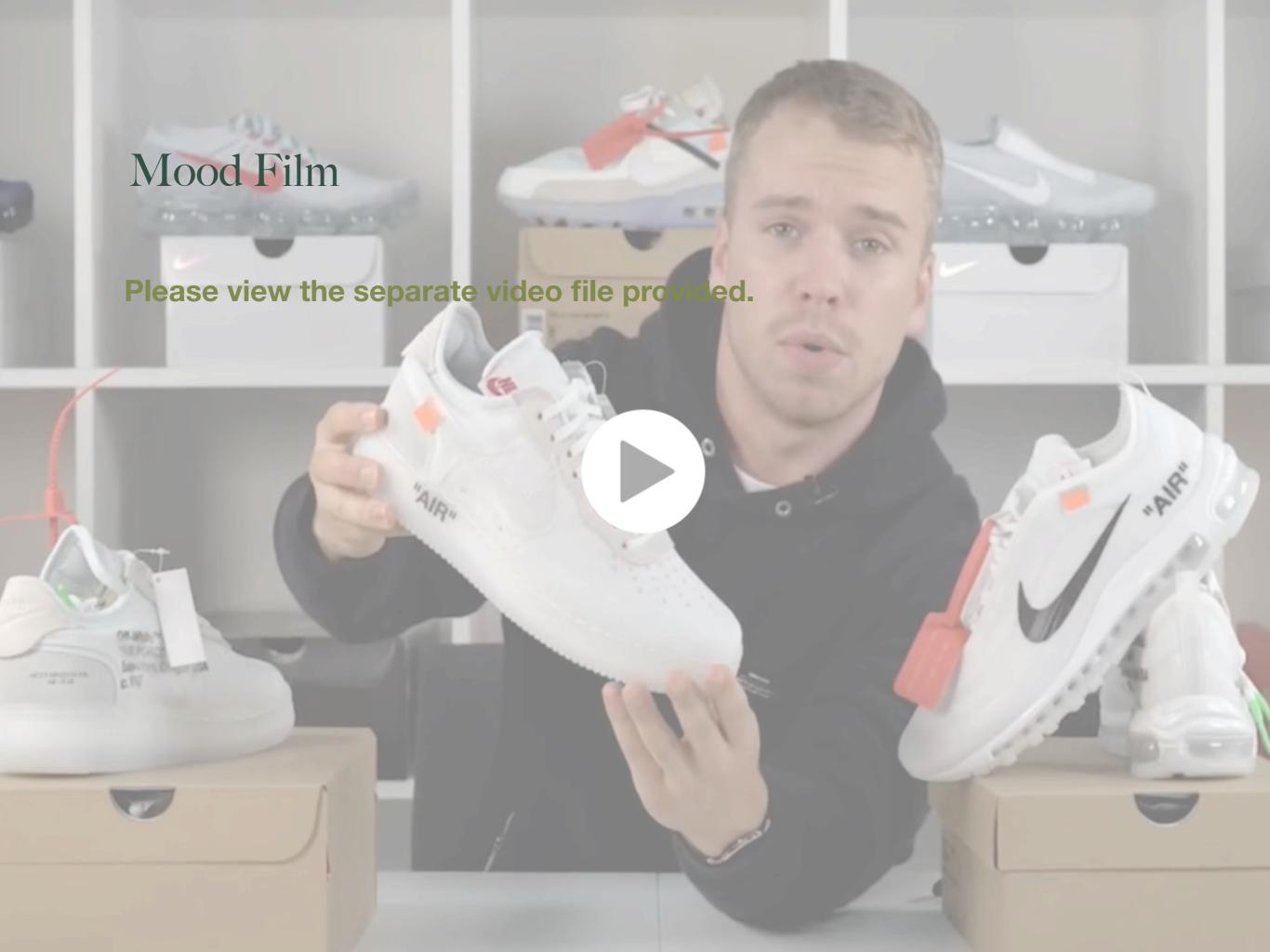

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Treatment

Our mood video captures the essence of streetwear culture, and represents our ideal visual tone. We intend to both adopt and challenge this culture, by removing the brandnew, pristine products usually shown, and featuring well-worn footwear that carries an important story and message.

We believe that using this contemporary and authentic visual language will allow us to tell these stories in a way that will resonate strongly with our primary target.

Our film will be shot as if it were an authentic sneaker review on a popular vlog - and will use a genuine vlogger in the lead role. The twist in our film being the shoes that are reviewed and the stories behind them.

SCRIPT NOTE: While we feel that our film will work as a scripted piece, our ideal execution of this script would feature a genuine sneaker vlogger in the lead role, as their natural method of delivery would add a layer of authenticity to the piece. We hope that the stories featured in the script reflect the true nature of Concern's fundraising and field work.

We open on a young **SNEAKER REVIEWER**. He's wearing stylish NIKE clothing and has a pair of pristine Air Max on. There's a table with two plain shoeboxes on it in front of him. This is an episode of his vlog.

SNEAKER REVIEWER:

To the camera.

What's up everyone? Okay, so I'm going to do something a little different today.

At the end of my last video I asked you to leave a comment and tell me about your favourite sneakers.

A guy named Patrick left a really interesting one, and I just had to feature his story.

He takes a pair of generic black trainers out of one of the boxes. They're worn and scuffed, but have been maintained. He holds one up.

These are Patrick Irvine's Leisure Trainers. One of one. Nothing else like 'em. Dope, right?

He laughs. Okay, I know you weren't expecting these - but hear me out.

Patrick works for a charity called **CONCERN**. See the scuffs? *Gesturing at the shoe*. The wear and tear?

They're like that because Patrick's a **STREET FUNDRAISER**. He's worked in Dublin for a few years now, trying to tell people about Concern.

And look - these aren't the worst...he's taken care of 'em. But when you're on your feet all day - your kicks will wear out.

Patrick told me it can be hard to get people to stop and talk to him. He said a lot of people simply don't know the difference between Concern and other charities.

He's out there trying to help the poorest of the poor. People in war torn regions. Families with no food and no clean water. In South Sudan, Nepal and more.

Patrick gave me a few stats to shout out about Concern. In 2016, they spent one hundred AND sixty seven million euro on charitable activities worldwide. That's crazy. And thirty six million of that came from public donations - the kind given to fundraisers like Patrick.

So - this might not be the most stylish pair I've ever featured, but man, I dunno how many of us could spend a day in Patrick's shoes.

He puts the shoes back in their box.

After talking to Patrick, I decided to find out some more about Concern. I wanted to know how funds are spent. That's when I met Isaac.

He takes a pair of leather boots out of the second box. They're well-worn and caked in dried mud.

Isaac is a Concern **FIELD WORKER**. These are his boots. And man, have these got a story to tell.

He holds one of the boots up. Isaac is just one of many local staff working for Concern in South Sudan. Check these out. Gestures at the boot. All this mud and dirt. Laughs. Now, you know I can't stand a pair of kicks in this kinda nick - but these have clearly lived a good life.

Isaac's been helping Concern fight ongoing food and nutrition issues over there - and said that they've distributed four hundred and forty thousand food rations in the area they're in. *Pauses.* That's unreal, isn't it? AND he's also working with them to bring safe drinking water to people all over the country.

It takes a lot of drive to get out there and help people day after day.

He puts the boots back in their box.

So, if you ask me, it's not always about having the freshest sneakers. Sometimes it's about how far a single pair can actually take you. And that some people are using theirs to go above and beyond to help make the world a better place.

He looks directly into the camera.

And y'know what? Respect to them.

We cut to a montage of images of Concern staff and volunteers from around the world holding their footwear up to camera - shot on phones and personal cameras.
